Gross pathology and histopathology sessions dedicated to veterinarians preparing for the ECLAM and ECVP boards will be included.

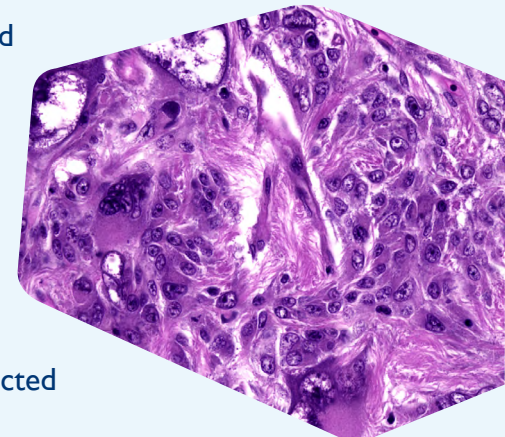
